



Forest Conservation Days 2012



The Santa Clara County Parks and Recreation Department and the Northern California Society of American Foresters invite the Boy Scouts to hike with a forester during the 2012 Forest Conservation Days (FCD) celebration to be held **March 24 and 25**. This celebration takes place at Sanborn Park located four miles above Saratoga off Big Basin Way (Hwy 9).

Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts are invited to a 2-3 hour interactive, hands-on hike with a forester through the redwood forest and the oak woodlands of Sanborn Park. Included will be tree identification, and instruction/activities on geology, soils, wildlife biology, native culture, fire fighting, forest products, demonstration of a vintage 1882 Steam Donkey, and more!

Please note, due to the presence of Sudden Oak disease in the Park, removal of leaf and bark samples is prohibited.

Badge requirements that could be filled on this hike:

- Tree species identification
- Forest products manufacturing
- Discussion about wildlife habitat & forest succession
- What contributions forests make to our quality of life
- Discussion about forest management; and
- Discussion about forestry as a career

Cloth patches commemorating FCD 2012 will be available for those scouts who attend and participate.
