From I-80

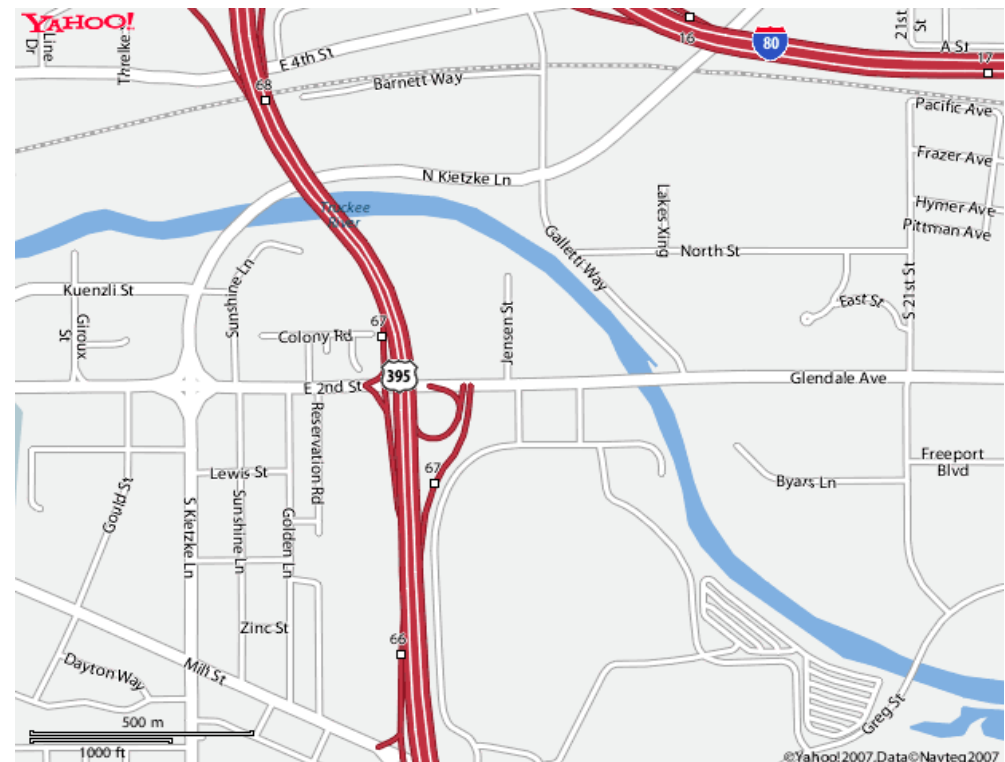
1. Take Hwy 395 South (in Reno)
